



HEATHCOTE ROAD UPGRADE ELECTRICAL & WATER ASSET RELOCATION



Gremalco has been awarded the contract for the Heathcote Road Upgrade – Electrical and Water asset relation work). The project involves upgrading a 2.2 km section of Heathcote Road between Infantry Parade, Holsworthy and The Avenue, Voyager Point.

Contract Value: \$4.5m

Gremalco's electrical scope includes relocating Endeavour Energy 11kV distribution cables from overhead to underground, street lighting installation, and early transmission works for the future Holsworthy zone substation.

The potable water scope involves the installation of twin lines, ranging in sizes from DN150 mm to DN710 mm featuring DICL, Steel and PE pipes, while the wastewater scope entails the construction of seven manholes, adjustments to existing manholes, and the installation of DN375 mm GRP pipes. Additionally, Gremalco will be relocating aqueducts at the Harris Creek crossing.

The Heathcote Road Upgrade is an important project in Sydney's busy south-west area. It will help ease congestion, improve road safety and provide more reliable and timely road journeys for road commuters.
